
From Sun, 19 July further permissions have eased. Social distancing & preventative measures must be observed.

#### **Daily COVID-19 Statistics For The Cayman Islands**


The Chief Medical Officer, Dr John Lee, reports 180 COVID-19 tests have been carried out since it was last reported on Thursday, 30 July. All were negative.

For symptomatic patients:

10 days after symptom onset, plus at least 3 additional days without symptoms (including without fever and without respiratory symptoms). Persons will then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.

For asymptomatic cases:

10 days after positive test for COVID-19. Persons will be then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.
