Open



Two-household gathering (high precautions)*



Small outdoor gatherings (25 people)



Retail



Preschool through 12th grade (local district choice)



Childcare



Manufacturing, construction, other work that is impossible to do remotely, including technical education



Public transit



Hair salons, barber shops, other personal services



Gyms, pools, roller and ice rinks



Restaurants and bars (outdoor dining, takeout, and delivery)



Professional sports**



Parks and outdoor recreation



Funerals (25 people)



Health care



Theaters, movie theaters, stadiums, arenas



Bowling centers



Bingo halls, casinos, arcades
