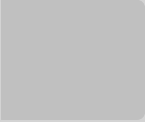

# Georgia Department of Public Health COVID-19 Daily Status Report

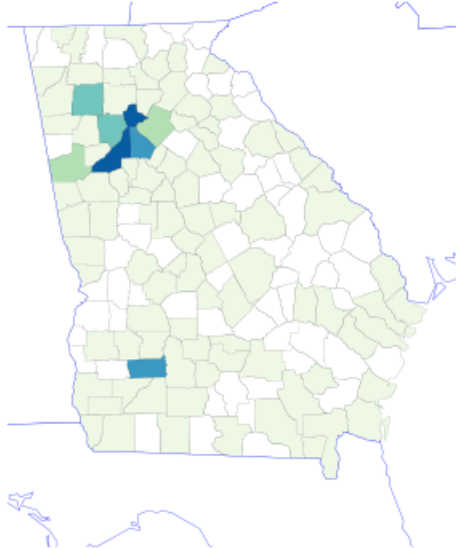

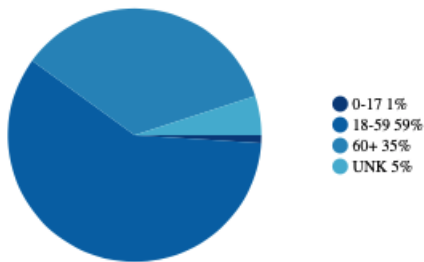

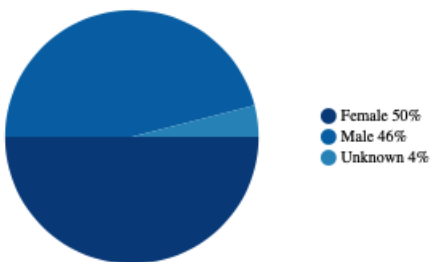
