Not all cases of COVID-19 are tested, so it is not a representative of the total number of people in Minnesota who have or had COVID-19. Number of positive cases is the cases that were tested and returned positive. All data are preliminary and may change as cases are investigated.

 - Patients who no longer need to be isolated: 260
- Total approximate number of completed tests: 18,822
 - Total approximate number of completed tests from the MDH Public Health Lab: 7,948
 - Total approximate number of completed tests from external laboratories: 10,874
- Deaths: 10
- Total cases requiring hospitalization: 92
 - Hospitalized as of today: 56
 - Hospitalized in ICU as of today: 24


