Latest case counts on novel coronavirus

March 13, 2020

A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19. BC has 53 confirmed cases, however, the risk of the virus spreading remains low.

- 64 confirmed cases including:
 - six individuals who have recovered, as indicated by the resolution of symptoms, followed by two successive negative test results 24 hours apart.
 - o One individual who has died.
