# Latest case counts on novel coronavirus

March 17, 2020

A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

## Confirmed COVID-19 cases

*Case counts are based on available information and are subject to change.*

### British Columbia

- **186 confirmed cases as of 3PM March 17, 2020.**
  - Five recovered
  - Seven deaths
  - By region:
    - 47 in Fraser Health
    - 7 in Interior Health
    - 12 in Island Health
    - 4 in Northern Health
    - 116 in Vancouver Coastal Health
- 6,326 individuals tested as of March 13, 2020.
