A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

Case counts are based on available information and are subject to change.

British Columbia

- **231 confirmed cases as of 3PM March 18, 2020.**
 - Five recovered
 - Seven deaths
 - By region:
 - 58 in Fraser Health
 - 9 in Interior Health
 - 16 in Island Health
 - 4 in Northern Health
 - 144 in Vancouver Coastal Health
- 6,326 individuals tested as of March 13, 2020.
