British Columbia

- 271 confirmed cases as of 3PM March 19, 2020.
 - Five recovered in BC
 - · Eight deaths in BC
 - · Cases by region:
 - 81 in Fraser Health
 - 12 in Interior Health
 - 22 in Island Health
 - 4 in Northern Health
 - 152 in Vancouver Coastal Health
- 17,912 individuals tested as of March 20, 2020.
