- 348 confirmed cases as of 3PM March 20, 2020.
 - Six recovered in BC
 - Nine deaths in BC
 - · Cases by region:
 - 95 in Fraser Health
 - 19 in Interior Health
 - 30 in Island Health
 - 4 in Northern Health
 - 200 in Vancouver Coastal Health
- 17,912 tests complete as of March 20, 2020.
