A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

Case counts are based on available information and are subject to change.

British Columbia

- **424 confirmed cases as of 3PM March 21, 2020.**
 - Six recovered in BC
 - 10 deaths in BC
 - Cases by region:
 - 126 in Fraser Health
 - 27 in Interior Health
 - 37 in Island Health
 - 4 in Northern Health
 - 230 in Vancouver Coastal Health
- 17,912 tests complete as of March 20, 2020.
