- 1,013 confirmed cases as of March 31.
 - o 507 recovered in BC
 - o 24 deaths in BC
 - · Cases by region:
 - 348 in Fraser Health
 - 107 in Interior Health
 - 67 in Island Health
 - 15 in Northern Health
 - 476 in Vancouver Coastal Health.
- 43,229 tests completed.
