April 10, 2020

A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

## **British Columbia**

- 1,410 confirmed cases as of April 10, 2020
  - 879 recovered in BC
  - 55 deaths in BC
  - · Cases by region:
    - 539 in Fraser Health
    - 132 in Interior Health
    - 84 in Island Health
    - 26 in Northern Health
    - 629 in Vancouver Coastal Health
  - o 53,505 tests completed as of April 9.
