Latest case counts on novel coronavirus

April 11, 2020

A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

Confirmed COVID-19 cases

Case counts are based on available information and are subject to change.

British Columbia

- 1,445 confirmed cases as of April 11, 2020
 - 905 recovered in BC
 - 58 deaths in BC
 - Cases by region:
 - 558 in Fraser Health
 - 135 in Interior Health
 - 84 in Island Health
 - 26 in Northern Health
 - 642 in Vancouver Coastal Health
 - 53,505 tests completed as of April 9.
