Latest case counts on novel coronavirus

April 13, 2020

A new coronavirus is causing a respiratory infection known as COVID-19 around the world and in B.C. The province is working to break the chains of transmission.

Confirmed COVID-19 cases

Case counts are based on available information and are subject to change.

British Columbia

- 1,490 confirmed cases as of April 13, 2020; (1,470 confirmed cases as of April 12, 2020)
 - 926 recovered in BC
 - o 69 deaths in BC
 - · Cases by region:
 - 591 in Fraser Health
 - 136 in Interior Health
 - 87 in Island Health
 - 26 in Northern Health
 - 650 in Vancouver Coastal Health
 - o 56,142 tests completed as of April 11.
