- 1,517 confirmed cases as of April 14, 2020
 - o 942 recovered in BC
 - 72 deaths in BC
 - · Cases by region:
 - 601 in Fraser Health
 - 141 in Interior Health
 - 89 in Island Health
 - 28 in Northern Health
 - 658 in Vancouver Coastal Health
 - o 58,626 tests completed as of April 14.
