

**Update - As of June 4, 2020**, B.C. is reporting <u>epi-linked cases</u>, meaning people who were never tested but were presumed to have COVID-19 because they developed symptoms and were close contacts of a laboratory confirmed case. Epi-linked cases identified since May 19, 2020, are now included in the case total, but are not considered new cases unless they were reported in the last 24 hours.

*Note: June 9, 2020:* One case reported to be in critical care in Northern Health Authority today was not reported as hospitalized due to reporting lags. Data will be updated tomorrow.
