Current Situation

Last updated: March 14, 2020

NEW Health care providers are strongly discouraging the public from visiting any health-care facility, including long-term care facilities, if they have returned from international travel in the past 14 days, been directed to self-monitor or self-isolate for 14 days, or are experiencing cold and flu symptoms, such as a cough, fever, runny nose, sore throat, headache or weakness.


Canadian Situation
