All Manitobans, including health care providers, are strongly advised to cancel or postpone any non-essential international travel.

Public health officials are recommending all international travellers should self-isolate and self-monitor for symptoms for 14 days after returning to Canada.

- ** A presumptive positive case has tested positive at Cadham Provincial Laboratory and is awaiting confirmatory testing results from the National Microbiology Laboratory.

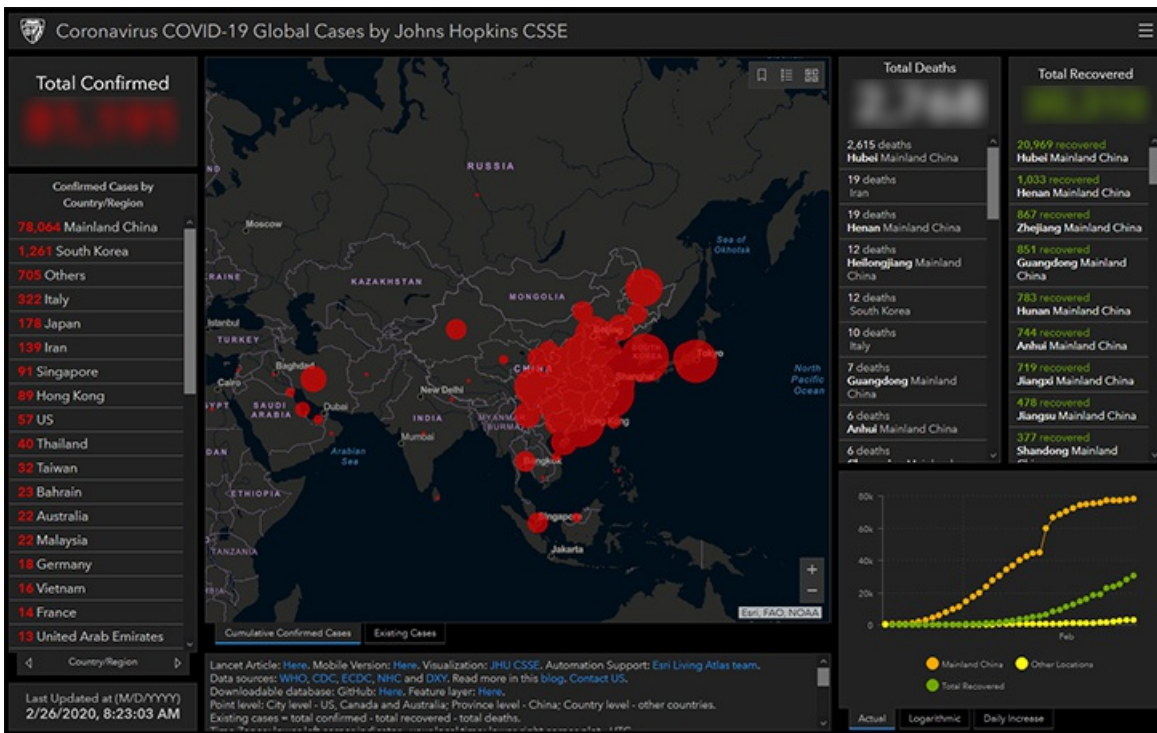
Canadian Situation

As of March 15, 2020 (9:00 am), 249 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Canada. Cases have been reported in Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Ontario, Prince Edward Island and Quebec. Four (4) probable cases have also been reported in Newfoundland & Labrador, New Brunswick and Saskatchewan..
