# **Current Situation**

NEW Last updated: March 21, 2020

Public health officials advise an additional case of COVID-19 has been identified, bringing the number of labconfirmed positive and presumptive positive cases in Manitoba to 18 at this time.

Case 18 is a woman in her 50s who lives in Winnipeg. At this time, the public health investigation indicates the case is related to travel. Information about flights where a person with a lab-confirmed case of COVID-19 had symptoms at the time of travel are updated on the <u>Flights with Confirmed Cases</u> page as information becomes available.

More locations are expected to open in the coming days, including a new drive-thru location in south Winnipeg.


### **Canadian Situation**

As of March 21, 2020 (8:00 am), 1,048 confirmed cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Canada. Cases have been reported in Alberta, British Columbia, Manitoba, New Brunswick, Nova Scotia, Ontario, Prince Edward Island, Quebec, Saskatchewan and Newfoundland & Labrador.
