Current Situation

Current Situation

Public health officials advise no new cases of COVID-19 have been identified as of 9:30 a.m. today. The total number of lab-confirmed positive and probable positive cases in Manitoba remains at 292.

The data also shows:

- no individuals in hospital or intensive care;
- 16 active cases and 269 individuals who have recovered from COVID-19; and
- the number of deaths due to COVID-19 remains at seven.

The draft plan for restoring services in Phase Two released May 21 builds on measures from *Restoring Safe Services: Manitoba's Pandemic and Economic Roadmap for Recovery,* which set out an evidence-based plan to ease public health measures that had escalated since mid-January. As of May 22, gathering size limits were increased to 25 people indoor and 50 outdoor, while professional sports teams were allowed to return to their training facilities, as long as precautions were taken

and the public is not allowed into those facilities.



Canadian Situation


NEW Last updated: April 25, 2020

As of April 25, 2020 (10:00 am), 44,353 confirmed cases, 11 probable cases and 2,350 deaths associated with COVID-19 have been confirmed in Canada. Cases have been reported in all provinces and territories across Canada, with the exception of Nunavut. Probable cases have all been reported in Manitoba. Deaths associated with COVID-19 have been reported in Alberta, British Columbia, Ontario, Manitoba, Newfoundland and Labrador, Nova Scotia, Quebec and Saskatchewan. <u>Public Health Agency of Canada's COVID-19: Outbreak update</u> website.
