Public health officials advise the current five-day COVID-19 test positivity rate is 1.7 per cent and 11 new cases of the virus have been identified as of 9:30 a.m. today bringing the number of cases in

The data shows: • one case in the Prairie Mountain Health region; • two cases in the Southern Health-Sante Sud; and • 8 cases in the Winnipeg health region. The data also shows: • 293 active cases and 1,191 individuals have recovered from COVID-19; • there are 10 people in hospital and two people in intensive care; and • the number of deaths due to COVID-19 is 16. Preliminary laboratory testing numbers show 1,403 on Wednesday, bringing the total number of lab tests completed since early February to 160,109. As testing site locations may change in response to changes in testing volumes, Manitobans are reminded to refer to the list of current testing sites and hours of operation before leaving home.
