Current Situation

NEW Last updated: October 12, 2020

Public health officials advise the 33rd and 34th deaths due to COVID-19 have been reported. One is a previously-announced case, a female in her 100s from Winnipeg linked to the Parkview Place

outbreak. The other is male in his 40s from Winnipeg.

The current five-day COVID-19 test positivity rate is 3.3 per cent and 77 new cases of the virus have been identified as of 9:30 a.m. bringing the total number of cases in Manitoba to 2,655.

Today's data shows:

- five cases in the Interlake-Eastern health region;
- five cases in the Northern health region;
- two cases in the Prairie Mountain Health region;
- nine cases in the Southern Health Santé Sud health region; and
- 56 cases in the Winnipeg health region.

The data also shows:

- 1131 active cases and 1,490 individuals have recovered from COVID-19;
- there are 25 people in hospital and four people in intensive care; and
- the number of deaths due to COVID-19 is 34.

Laboratory testing numbers show 1,871 tests were completed yesterday bringing the total number of lab tests completed since early February to 210,902. Case investigations continue and if a public health risk is identified, the public will be notified.
