### **Current Situation**

NEW Last updated: November 4, 2020 Public health officials advise two additional deaths due to COVID-19 have been reported today, including:

- a female in her 80s from the Winnipeg health region and linked to the outbreak at Maples personal care home; and
- A female in her 90s from the Winnipeg health region and linked to the outbreak at St. Boniface hospital.

The current five-day COVID-19 test positivity rate is 8.5 per cent and 374 new cases of the virus have been identified as of 9:30 a.m. and brings the total lab-confirmed cases in Manitoba to 6,751.

The test positivity rate in Winnipeg is 9 per cent. Officials advise this number does not reflect the situation in other parts of the province, as cases continue to be identified outside Winnipeg.

Today's data shows:

- 12 cases in the Interlake-Eastern health region;
- 14 cases in the Northern health region;
- five cases in the Prairie Mountain Health region;
- 67cases in the Southern Health-Santé Sud health region; and
- 276 cases in the Winnipeg health region.

The data also shows:

- 3,772 active cases and 2,892 individuals who have recovered from COVID-19;
- there are 140 people in hospital and 21 people in intensive care; and
- the number of deaths due to COVID-19 is 87.

Laboratory testing numbers show 3,163 tests were completed yesterday, bringing the total number of lab tests completed since early February to 268,504. Case investigations continue and if a public health risk is identified, the public will be notified.
