Current Situation

NEW Last updated: November 11, 2020

Public health officials advise nine additional deaths due to COVID-19 have been reported today,

including:

- a male in his 60's from Winnipeg health region;
- A female in her 60's from the Northern Health region;
- A male in his 70's from the Southern Health-Sante Sud region;
- A male in his 70's from Winnipeg health and linked to the St. Boniface Hospital outbreak;
- A male in his 70's from the Winnipeg health region and linked to the Parkview Place outbreak;
- A male in his 70's from the Winnipeg health region and linked to the Misericordia Place Personal Care Home;
- A female in her 70's from the Interlake-Eastern health region;
- A female in her 80's from Winnipeg health region and linked to the Victoria hospital outbreak; and
- A male in his 80's from the Winnipeg health region and linked to the Seine River Retirement Residence, Assisted Living Facility cluster.

The current five-day COVID-19 test positivity rate is 10.7 per cent provincially and 10.8 per cent in Winnipeg, and 431 new cases of the virus have been identified as of 9:30 a.m. bringing the total lab-confirmed cases in Manitoba to 9,308.

Today's data shows:

- 32 cases in the Interlake-Eastern health region;
- 33 cases in the Northern health region;
- 13 cases in the Prairie Mountain Health region;
- 101 cases in the Southern Health-Santé Sud health region; and
- 252 cases in the Winnipeg health region.

The data also shows:

- 5,676 active cases and 3,509 individuals who have recovered from COVID-19;
- there are 218 people in hospital with 32 people in intensive care; and
- the number of deaths due to COVID-19 is 123.

Laboratory testing numbers show 5,334 tests were completed yesterday, bringing the total number of lab tests completed since early February to 296,352. Case investigations continue and if a public health risk is identified, the public will be notified.
