Current Situation

NEW Last updated: March 30, 2021

Public health officials advise that no additional deaths in people with COVID-19 are being reported today.

The current five-day COVID-19 test positivity rate is 4.3 per cent provincially and 3.5 per cent in Winnipeg. As of 9:30 a.m. today, 77 new cases of the virus have been identified. This brings the total number of lab-confirmed cases in Manitoba to 34,052.

Public health officials are announcing that 11 new screened or sequenced cases of variant of concerns have been detected, one from the Interlake-Eastern health region, three from the Southern Health-Santé Sud health region and seven from the Winnipeg health region.

Today's COVID-19 data shows:

- one case in the Interlake-Eastern health region;
- 27 cases in the Northern health region;
- one case in the Prairie Mountain Health region;
- five cases in the Southern Health-Santé Sud health region; and
- 43 cases in the Winnipeg health region.
