


PEI COVID-19 Case Data

* What does recovered mean?

A case is deemed recovered if it has been 14 days since symptoms began; the individual does not have a fever and symptoms have markedly improved. If a case was asymptomatic (no symptoms), we use the date of the test to start the 14 days.
