


# Cases and Risk of COVID-19 in Saskatchewan



## COVID-19 Cases Per Zone

Effective May 11, 2020

### Summary

As of May 11th, there are four (4) new cases of COVID-19 in Saskatchewan - four (4) new confirmed cases and no (0) new presumptive positive cases - bringing the total to 568 reported cases.

- New cases are in the Far North (4) region
- No (0) new cases were Saskatchewan residents tested out of province
- 568 cases are confirmed and none (0) are presumptive (referred to RRPI /NMI for confirmatory testing)

- 568 cases are confirmed and none (0) are presumptive (referred to RRPL/NMEL for confirmatory testing)
- 199 cases out of the 568 cases are considered active (35.0%)
- 79 of the cases are individuals in the 19 and under age category; all others are adults, with 50% of the cases are males and 50% are females
- 66 cases are a result of local exposures that are unidentifiable and are not related to travel or mass gathering/event-related
- 48 cases are healthcare workers, although the source of their infections may not be health care related
- A total of 11 individuals are hospitalized; including eight (8) inpatient hospitalizations and three (3) ICU hospitalizations
- Six (6) Saskatchewan residents with COVID-19 have died. Saskatchewan now has a fatality rate of 1.1%
- A total of 363 individuals have recovered (63.9%)
- To date, 37,439 COVID-19 tests have been performed




