

Cases and Risk of COVID-19 in Saskatchewan



Summary

As of May 14, there are five (5) new cases of COVID-19 in Saskatchewan, bringing the total to 582 reported cases.

- New cases are the Far North (4) and Regina (1) regions
- No (0) new cases were Saskatchewan residents tested out of province
- 582 cases are confirmed and none (0) are presumptive (referred to RRPL/NML for confirmatory testing)
- 178 cases out of the 582 cases are considered active (30.6%)

- 210 cases are in the fer north 102 cases are from the Casketaen area 100 cases
- 210 cases are in the far north, 163 cases are from the Saskatoon area, 106 cases are from the north, 76 cases are from the Regina area, 15 cases are from the south and 12 cases are from the central area
- 81 cases are individuals in the 19 and under age category; all others are adults, with 49% of the cases are males and 51% are females
- 139 cases are travel-related, 302 are either contacts or linked to a mass gathering event, 67 have no known exposures and 74 are under investigation by local public health
- 48 cases are healthcare workers, although the source of their infections may not be health care related
- 10 individuals are hospitalized; including seven (7) inpatient hospitalizations and three (3) in ICU hospitalization
- Six (6) Saskatchewan residents with COVID-19 have died. Saskatchewan now has a fatality rate of 1.0%
- A total of 398 individuals have recovered (68.4%)
- 38,728 COVID-19 tests had been performed in Saskatchewan




