- February 15, 2021: The probable case that was announced February 12 is confirmed to be positive. No additional potential exposure notices have been issued.
- February 13, 2021 3 additional exposure notices were issued.
- February 12, 2021 We confirmed 1 new case in Yukon and issued 2 exposure notices.
