- February 15, 2021: The probable case that was <u>announced February 12</u> is confirmed to be positive. No additional potential exposure notices have been issued.
- February 13, 2021 <u>3 additional exposure notices</u> were issued.
- February 12, 2021 We confirmed 1 new case in Yukon and issued 2 exposure notices.
