Daily COVID-19 Statistics For The Cayman Islands

The Chief Medical Officer, Dr John Lee, reports 342 COVID-19 tests have been carried out since this was last reported on Wednesday, 7 October. One was positive. The individual is a returning traveller who tested positive during routine screening and will remain in isolation until recovered.

For symptomatic patients:

10 days after symptom onset, plus at least 3 additional days without symptoms (including without fever and without respiratory symptoms). Persons will then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.

For asymptomatic cases:

10 days after positive test for COVID-19. Persons will be then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.
