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Daily COVID-19 Statistics For The Cayman Islands

The Chief Medical Officer, Dr. John Lee, reports that 227 COVID-19 tests have been carried out since this was last reported on Monday, 30 November 2020. Three were positive. The individuals are travellers who returned positive test results following routine screening and are asymptomatic. They will remain in isolation until considered recovered.

For symptomatic patients:

10 days after symptom onset, plus at least 3 additional days without symptoms (including without fever and without respiratory symptoms). Persons will then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.

For asymptomatic cases:

10 days after positive test for COVID-19. Persons will then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.
