Daily COVID-19 Statistics For The Cayman Islands


The Chief Medical Officer, Dr. John Lee, reports that 339 COVID-19 tests have been carried out since this was last reported on Thursday, 28 January 2021. Three were positive. The individuals are asymptomatic travellers who tested positive following routine screening. They will remain in isolation until considered recovered. The total number of people vaccinated in the Cayman Islands is now 7,853, including 289 second doses. Read more

For symptomatic patients:


10 days after symptom onset, plus at least 3 additional days without symptoms (including without fever and without respiratory symptoms). Persons will then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.

For asymptomatic cases:

10 days after positive test for COVID-19. Persons will be then be retested and must obtain two negative tests 24 hours apart.
