

## Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 7th May, 2020

On 07/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached).

The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that no new Covid-19 case has been detected after 3rd April 2020. As on date, Goa has had seven positive cases of Covid-19, and all seven patients have recovered. After recovery, these patients were shifted to a Quarantine facility outside the Covid Hospital, as per norms for further institutional quarantine of 14 days, and they all have thereafter been sent for home quarantine of 14 days as per laid down protocols. 386 tests for Covid (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey), were done during the last 24 hours, on SARI/ILI patients, all of which were negative. The SEC noted with caution that Goa had not yet faced any community transmission.
2. Shri Kunal, the Nodal Officer, informed that tomorrow a train is planned to leave Goa for Gwalior with over 1,000 migrants from Madhya Pradesh. The Madhya Pradesh government has paid for their tickets to the Railways authorities. He also informed that some more trains are planned soon, and additionally, many people are leaving by road. The SEC advised him to have close coordination with receiving State Govt authorities and Goa Govt officers for their smooth movement.
3. Collector, North-Goa informed that the KTCL bus has safely reached Silvassa, which was permitted by SEC yesterday. For the return journey, the bus would be used to transport some stranded Goan. She also informed that the KTCL bus with JNV students has reached Ratlam and the Delhi bound students stranded in Goa have been put on the bus which came from Delhi with the Students from Goa. This bus is now returning with those stranded Goa students. Another bus that had gone to Kerala has started it's return journey, and is likely to pick up the stranded persons of

Goa, enroute. The SEC advised the safety of passengers should be a priority while planning such trips.

4. Secretary, Ports informed that MEA has operationalized a portal to share information with the States on the people coming from outside India. Mr Anthony De'Souza, the Nodal officer for NRIs is coordinating the various aspects. The SEC directed the Nodal officer to regularly share the details with Shri PS Reddy and the SEC.
5. PCE(PWD) informed that water supply is normal. Earlier in the day, the department had a video-conference with the Department of Drinking Water & Sanitation, GoI. In the VC, the State has to work on providing piped water supply to all households in the State by 31 Mar 2021.
6. Collector, North-Goa informed that two buses, with 25 passengers/migrants each, would leave for Tamil Nadu tomorrow. The SEC permitted the movement as the Tamil Nadu government has already given the permission.
7. Secretary, Law informed that the Registration process has picked up and the department has registered 34 documents and 16 marriages during the day. The SEC advised the department to keep the process staggered to ensure the social distancing and other safety norms.
8. Commissioner (Excise) informed that the liquor manufacturers have produced about 5.53 lakh liters of hand sanitisers.
9. Secretary, Agriculture informed that the agricultural activities are normal. With 12 Harvesters working in the fields, 90% harvesting is complete and sowing for vegetables has begun.
10. The SEC discussed the issue of facilitation of smooth movement of trucks at Patradevi. The SEC suggested that additional manpower and supporting infrastructure needs to be deployed. PCE(PWD) was asked to coordinate with the major project construction agencies such as DBL, GGIAL, etc. and assist the Collector North Goa for putting in place additional counters for border verification of the entering vehicles, to facilitate timely movement of trucks carrying goods and construction material for important public projects.
11. CE(Electricity) informed that power supply is normal in the State. He added that the State's electricity consumption has reached to about 84 percent as compared to the previous year. In seven Industrial Estates, the power consumption has returned to normal.
12. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 238 persons are sheltered in 11 quarantine facilities. He is visiting these facilities regularly.

13. Secretary, Civil Supply informed that about 70% of regular NFSA Antyodaya, 58% of PHH, and 48 % of the APL stock have been distributed by FPS. As regards PMGKAY, 44% stock of AAY and 32% of stock of PHH has been distributed. Under Annapurana, the distribution has been completed for about 40 % card holders in respect of rice. Pulses distribution for APL and Annapurna is slowly gaining pace.
14. MD, KTCL informed that today KTCL ran 185 buses and no relief buses.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
