Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 8th May, 2020

On 08/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

- 1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
- 2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
- 3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached).

The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

- 1. Status of COVID19: Secretary Health informed that no new Covid-19 case has been detected after 3rd April 2020. As on date, Goa has had seven positive cases of Covid-19, and all seven patients have recovered. After recovery, these patients were shifted to a Quarantine facility outside the Covid Hospital, as per norms for further institutional quarantine of 14 days, and they all have thereafter been sent for home quarantine as per laid down protocols. 358 tests for Covid (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey), were done during the last 24 hours, on SARI/ILI patients, all of which were negative. The SEC noted with caution that Goa had not yet faced any community transmission.
- 2. Shri Kunal confirmed that a train with 1196 passengers left Goa for Gwalior, Madhya Pradesh, as was informed to the SEC yesterday. After screening, seven passengers were held back as thermal guns showed higher temperature, who were sent for medical checkup and testing. He also informed that movement of some more trains and buses are planned soon. Additionally, many people are leaving by road. The SEC advised him to have close coordination with receiving State Govt authorities and Goa Govt officers for their smooth movement.
- 3. Secretary, Health informed that the department has received some information about indelible ink causing skin reaction. Although, no such complaints are received in other States who are using the similar ink, the department has decided to change the current stock of the ink after obtaining a fresh stock, as a precautionary measure. Indent for the fresh stock has already been placed.
- 4. Secretary, Education informed about the board exams are planned from 20 May, 2020. She informed that all measures would be taken while conducting the

examinations, for ensuring social distancing, use of maks, sanitizers, etc. for the safe conduct of examinations.

- 5. PCE(PWD) informed that the water supply is normal.
- PCE(PWD) further added that he, alongwith Collector, North-Goa are working out a
 mechanism to streamline the movement of trucks at Patradevi as the average time
 taken for clearing the trucks needs to be minimised. The SEC advised the District
 Observers to monitor the same.
- 7. Secretary, Law informed that the Registration process has picked up and the department has registered 36 documents and 8 marriages during the day. The SEC advised the department to keep the process staggered to ensure the social distancing and other safety norms.
- 8. Commissioner (Excise) informed that the liquor manufacturers have produced about 5.65 lakh liters of hand sanitisers.
- Secretary, Agriculture informed that the agricultural activities are normal. With 12
 Harvesters working in the fields, 91% harvesting is complete and sowing for
 vegetables is going on and is likely to pick up gradually with the onset of Monsoon.
- 10. Director, IT informed that the citizens with feature phones and landline can get the protection of the Arogya Setu app by calling a toll free number 1921. Call will get disconnected and the caller will receive a call back to take information on the self assessment, as asked in AarogyaSetu App. Based on the responses given, citizens will get a SMS indicating his/her health status. Ministry of Health & FW, Gol has also put more details regarding the service on the MOHFW website (http://mohfw.nic.in).
- 11. Secretary, Port informed that he is coordinating with the owner/representatives of the incoming ships. However, their plans keep changing frequently. On 13th May, one ship is expected to arrive at MPT, and arrival of a few other ships is also planned in the near future.
- 12. Principal Secretary, Science and Technology informed that production in the Pharmaceuticals units have reached above 90% of the pre-lockdown levels.
- 13. MD, KTCL informed that JNV students who have come back from Delhi, have been dropped at the Quarantine facility, for testing purposes. The SEC advised the Secretary, Health to coordinate their testing. MD also requested permission to send two KTCL buses to Kerala to drop some residents of Kerala. The SEC permitted the movement subject to adherence to the necessary safety measures.
- 14. The SEC advises all concerned to dispose of the condemned vehicles before the arrival of Monsoon, to prevent breeding of mosquitoes and other health hazards.

- 15. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 275 persons are sheltered in 11 quarantine facilities. He is visiting these facilities regularly.
- 16. Secretary, Civil Supply informed the distribution of ration is going on. 77% of AAY card holders and 66% of PHH cardholders have lifted their regular NFSA quota. PMGKAY quota is lifted by almost 55% of AAY card holders and 42% of PHH cardholders.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
