

Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 14th May, 2020

On 14/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that 589 tests for Covid (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey), were done during the last 24 hours, on SARI/ILI patients. For Goa, this is the highest number of the Covid tests done so far in any day. All tests were negative except one.
2. Secretary, Health informed that a seafarer has tested positive. He was tested negative in Mumbai after Sign off, and was for 14 days in quarantine in Mumbai. He reached the border at 4 am in the morning today and was taken to a quarantine centre where he was kept in isolation and his throat swab was taken for testing. He tested positive and has been shifted to the Covid Hospital. However, the SEC advised the Health department to have a detailed discussion with the patient for getting information on the possible contacts he could have had during the journey, and this information be shared with the all concerned for effective contract tracing and testing by the Government of Maharashtra.
3. After the recent positive cases emerging amongst the travellers, the SEC decided that the practice of testing every incoming person needs to continue. The SEC discussed the issue of charging the people for the cost of testing. After deliberations, the SEC directed the Inter-State Movement Cell of Goa to convey the following to the Railways and other authorities:
 - o any traveller coming to Goa will have to go through compulsory testing;
 - o a testing fee of Rs. 2,000/- per person shall be charged, except from those who are covered under the Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana or

under any other exempted category like government staff on duty, etc, irrespective of mode of travel;

- These travellers will be taken to the holding area/quarantine centre as per the laid down protocol. Their throat swabs would be taken and sent for testing.
 - Those coming by train must have a valid residential address in Goa with documentary proof of the same. If the destination is neighbouring States of Maharashtra or Karnataka, they should possess prior permission of the respective State Governments and should have made their own travel arrangements. Absence of prior permission of the respective State may result in their being sent back by the next available train and all resultant cost will have to be borne by them. They will also be liable for punitive action.
 - Only after testing negative, these travellers shall be permitted to go for a compulsory Home quarantine of 14 days. Till then, they will be kept in isolation in the holding areas.
4. The SEC directed the Inter-State Movement Cell to send bulk SMSs to all the incoming travellers with an online link for filling up the Self Declaration Form (in the attached format) and ensure downloading of Arogya Setu app. Arrangements may also be made, if required, to make available these forms in paper format at the Railway Stations or in the train.
 5. Collector, South-Goa informed that the district has made arrangements for people who are coming by trains. After a field visit, the district and health authorities have decided to collect the throat swab samples either in the Railway station or at the new South District Hospital. After disembarking from the train, people would be taken in the buses to the new South District Hospital or Fatorda stadium, for testing and keeping them in isolation.
 6. The SEC also clarified that Shri PS Reddy shall continue to supervise movement of all persons who are coming either by sea or by air; and the Inter-state Movement Cell will continue to handle the movement of persons by train and bus. The Collectors will continue to coordinate the various movements and will provide necessary support to Shri PS Reddy and Inter-state Movement Cell.
 7. PCE(PWD) informed that water supply is normal. At Tillary, there was a slight shortfall of production and is expected to become normal soon.
 8. Collector, North-Goa informed that one holding area has been proposed at the Peddam Sports complex. Some people who came in 3 buses through Keri checkpoint were taken to this holding area today, after collection of their throat swabs at Asilo Hospital. The SEC asked her to monitor the new arrangements for a feedback on its functioning, for exploring the possibility of identifying similar areas as and when required.

9. The Nodal Officer (Foreigners) informed that till date 7352 foreigners have left Goa in 36 special ferry flights from the Goa Airport. He further informed that in few cases, foreign nationals arrive in Goa with tickets but without the MEA clearance. For such cases, the MEA has allowed them to board the flights. He further proposed that foreign nationals who have flight tickets may be allowed to come in the State subject to putting them up at designated hotels till they board their flight. The SEC agreed with his suggestion.
10. Secretary, Civil Supply informed that the distribution of ration is going on well. She further added that, as per media reports, the Gol has announced free distribution of 5 kg of rice or wheat and one kg of 'channa' for the next two months for migrant labour.
11. MD, KTCL informed that 178 buses were operational today. The four KTCL buses have gone out of the State to Bijapur, Gadag, Mangalore, Kochi. The SEC approved the movement subject to following the requisite safety protocol.
12. Secretary, Law informed that the department has registered 33 documents and 22 marriages during the day. The SEC advised the department to keep the process staggered to ensure the social distancing and other safety norms.
13. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 359 persons are sheltered in 11 quarantine facilities. He is visiting these facilities regularly.
14. IGP informed that the police have so far taken action against 10007 persons for non-wearing of masks and against 6460 persons for spitting at public places. The SEC advised the continuation of the strict action in this regard.
15. CE(Electricity) informed that the power supply is adversely affected in the Bicholim area due to rain and wind. The work is on to restore the same.
16. Director, IT informed that 17085 people have moved out of the State and 2129 have entered since 29th April 2020.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.

Please Note:-

- COVID-19 testing is mandatory on arrival in Goa and Rs 2000 per person will be charged for the test except from those who are covered under , Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Aarogya Yojana or any other exempted category. After arrival in Goa testing will be done at suitable location and thereafter, you will be kept in isolation till test results are out. This may take 8-10 hours. After being tested COVID-19 (ve), you will be required to undergo 14 days mandatory Home Quarantine and marking/stamping will done on your arm for the same.
- If your end destination is Goa, you must have a valid residential address in Goa and carry a documentary proof of the same. If your end destination is in the neighbouring states of Maharashtra or Karnataka you should furnish prior permission from the respective State Government at the station and make necessary travel arrangements for your onward journey without any delay. If you don't furnish the permission letter or if you deboard at Goa without having proof of a valid residential address in Goa, you will be sent back by the next available train and all costs incurred in this process will be borne by you. Furthermore, punitive action may also be taken against you.
