

Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 24th May, 2020

On 24/05/2020, Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Minister of Health attended the meeting of the State Executive Committee (SEC). Shri Parimal Rai, Chief Secretary/Chairman (SEC) (who is also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and all the following members also attended the SEC meeting:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that 591 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative except 11. Three patients were cured and shifted out of Covid hospital. The total number of active cases is 47.
2. Collector, South-Goa informed that DG Shipping has issued a new SOP for seafarers who are in the Indian Exclusive Economic Zone (EEZ). As per the SOP, such seafarers should be allowed to go home, after testing negative for Covid, without going through any mandatory quarantine. The SEC decided to adopt these guidelines.
3. After discussion with the Chief Minister and the Health Minister, the SEC decided to modify the proposed SOP for handling of incoming passengers, as follows:
 - o Anyone coming to the State shall have to fill a Self Declaration Form (as annexed) giving their contact details and address. Additionally, they would be required to opt for either:
 - i. Compulsory 14-days home quarantine
 - ii. Paid testing at the time of arrival; or
 - iii. produce Covid negative certificate from an ICMR approved laboratory, issued within 48 hours of arrival in Goa.

- Any domestic passenger, irrespective of mode of travel, will be screened with Thermal scanners. After screening, anyone with fever or other symptoms shall undergo compulsory Covid testing.
 - The movement of international passengers will be dealt as per the guidelines issued by the MHA from time to time.
 - People who opt for home quarantine shall be monitored by the Health workers, as per the existing protocol.
4. Shri Kunal, the Nodal officer, informed that one train left for Jharkhand with 1660 passengers.
 5. The Nodal Officer (Foreigners) informed that till date 7774 foreigners have left Goa in 39 special ferry flights from the Goa Airport.
 6. Commissioner (Excise) informed that the liquor manufacturers have produced about 6.52 lakh liters of hand sanitisers.
 7. The SEC was informed that the vessel, MT Basra, stuck about 12 nautical miles from Goan coast for the last many days, has left for Karwar for its repair.
 8. The SEC was informed that a total of 989 persons (out of them 631 are seafarers, 49 railway passengers, 13 stranded Indians) are currently sheltered in different quarantine facilities.
 9. Mr Anthony De'Souza, the Nodal officer for NRIs informed that KTCL bus has picked up 23 Goans. 14 of them have arrived by a flight in Mumbai from the UK and nine were the seafarers who have completed their 14 days quarantine at Mumbai.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
