

Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 28th May, 2020

On 28/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
2. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that 887 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative except one. One patient was cured and shifted out of Covid hospital. The total number of active cases is 31.
2. Secretary, Health informed that four of the six scheduled flights have landed with 130 passengers. These passengers are undergoing testing.
3. Secretary, Law informed that the department has registered 44 documents and 08 marriages during the day. The SEC advised the department to keep the process staggered to ensure the social distancing and other safety norms.
4. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 144 persons (including 45 seafarers) are sheltered in quarantine facilities.
5. CE(Elect) informed that a transformer failed yesterday that adversely affected the power supply in the Ponda area. The department had restored the power supply the same day.
6. The Nodal Officer (Foreigners) informed that till date 8131 foreigners have left Goa in 40 special ferry flights from the Goa Airport.
7. The SEC reviewed the preparedness of the monsoon. Secretary, Fisheries informed that the department has issued the necessary warnings to the fishermen. IGP informed that he has reviewed the departmental preparation. Collector, North-Goa has planned for a review meeting to be held tomorrow. The SEC was informed of the latest bulletin of IMD, wherein heavy rainfall is expected on 31st May and 1st June 2020. All departments concerned should be in high alertness and take all precautions to minimise possibility of damage to property and life.



8. Secretary, Health was of the opinion that some of the doctors deployed at the Railway stations could be relieved from the task of screening the passengers, which can be done by other trained health workers. This will help make available the doctors for other important duties with regard to vector borne diseases, which are likely during the monsoon. The SEC asked the Collectors to work on this proposal.
9. PCE(PWD) informed that the PWD team visited the Cortalim junction with SP(Traffic), as earlier directed by the SEC. The team has assessed the situation and has given suitable directions to ensure smooth traffic during the monsoon by making sufficient right of way available.
10. Director, IT informed that 75076 people have moved out of the State and 5906 have entered since 29th April 2020. In Goa, 2,62,632 people have downloaded the Arogya Setu application so far.
11. MD, KTCL informed that 148 buses were operational today.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
