# Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 29th May, 2020

On 29/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

- 1. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
- 2. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

- Status of COVID19: Secretary Health informed that 984 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative. Three patients were cured and shifted out of Covid hospital. The total number of active cases is 28.
- 2. Shri Kunal, the Nodal officer, informed that today one train is planned to go to Jharkhand.
- 3. The SEC was informed that today one flight came early morning from Italy with 276 seafarers, amongst them 206 were Goan. They have been shifted to designated hotels for testing and quarantine, the rest have departed for their home States by road.
- 4. The SEC was informed that one special flight is bringing cargo for Indian Navy from Nasik, and would land at Goa on 1st June 2020. As the crew is coming for official work for the Navy, they would be subjected to the existing protocol of testing, and if found negative to be allowed to work.
- 5. Secretary, Health informed that Asilo District Hospital, Mapusa received a large number of people for testing last evening. Due to this unexpected rush, some of them were shifted to other testing facilities. This rush was due to the surge in the number of people coming through Patradevi check post after 5 pm. The SEC asked Secretary Health to explore the alternatives to manage such high numbers.

A Total

- Secretary, Law informed that the department has registered 52 documents and 13 marriages during the day. The SEC advised the department to keep the process staggered to ensure the social distancing and other safety norms.
- 7. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 338 persons (including 206 seafarers who came by flight today) are sheltered in quarantine facilities.
- MD, KTCL informed that 155 buses were operational today. He further added that buses sent to drop nationals of Iran at Mumbai airport would bring back 13 Goans, who came from Sri Lanka by special flight.
- 9. Director, IT informed that 2,62,632 people have downloaded the Arogya Setu app so far in Goa. She shared the summary of the health profile of the people registered on Arogya Setu. The SEC asked her to keep close coordination with Secretary Health to ensure correctness of the data entry and for follow up of the health protocols, as required.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
