# Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 30th May, 2020

On 30/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

- 1. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
- 2. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

- Status of COVID19: Secretary Health informed that 1768 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative except one. One patient was cured and shifted out of Covid hospital. The total number of active cases is 28.
- 2. Secretary, Health informed that the team of the Health department alongwith PWD officers visited Patradevi to examine the feasibility of taking a throat swab sample at the checkpost. The team observed that creating such an infrastructure for such a testing facility may not be feasible at the checkpost. The SEC asked the PCE(PWD), Health Department and Collector to explore the possibility to utilise any nearby facility for the purpose of collection of throat swab samples.
- Secretary, Health informed that 1536 persons with ILI type symptoms and 220 for SARI like symptoms have been tested so far in the State.
- Secretary, Health informed that 148 passengers have landed in Goa today by two flights; their throat swab samples have been taken and testing is going on.
- 5. The SEC discussed the order of the SC issued yesterday regarding stranded migrant workers, especially the directions on providing free transport, food & water, medical screening to the migrant workers. The SEC directed the Collectors and other officers handling the issue of stranded labourers to ensure compliance of the SC orders and to facilitate migrant workers to reach their home States.

- PCE(PWD) informed that due to power failure at Salaulim, the water supply was adversely affected. CE(Electricity) informed that this happened due to low voltage. The water supply returned to normal as the problem has since been rectified.
- 7. Collector North-Goa sought clarification on whether people who were earlier sent to Home Quarantine after testing negative, may be allowed to move freely in view of the changed SOP. The SEC clarified that their movement need not to be monitored any more if they were tested negative.
- 8. Shri Kunal, the Nodal officer, informed that 3 trains are to depart today, one to WB and two to Bihar.
- 9. It was brought out that Goa Airport Director has informed that an Air Srilanka flight is expected to land in Goa tomorrow evening with 162 stranded Indian passengers/Seafarers from Sri Lanka. The nodal officer for stranded NRIs, Mr P S Reddy and Mr Anthony were asked to coordinate this arrival as per laid down SOP.
- 10. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 286 persons (including 206 seafarers) are sheltered in quarantine facilities.
- 11. MD, KTCL informed that 130 buses were operational today.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
