

Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 25th May, 2020

On 25/05/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached). The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.

After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that 239 reports were received for Covid tests (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey for SARI/ILI patients), during the last 24 hours, and all were negative except one. The total number of active cases is 48. Covid test results for those persons, who came by flights today and opted for the testing, are negative.
2. Secretary, Health informed that two flights and one train came today. They opted for either Home quarantine or testing. She further added that the department has set up a strict protocol for the monitoring of people who opted for Home quarantine. The Health department will give them a printed copy of detailed guidelines for Home quarantine. The SEC asked Secretary Health, Collectors and Director, Tourism to work out options for persons who would like to avail paid institutional quarantine facilities.
3. Shri Kunal, the Nodal Officer, informed that two trains have left today, one to the UP and one to Jharkhand. One more train will leave for Orissa in the night. Shri Kunal further added that 11 girls from Jharkhand were sent back to their State, by the Shramik special train, after the labour department intervened to arrange for the payment of their unpaid salary from their employees.
4. Secretary, Civil Supply informed that she is coordinating with the Collectors to distribute the free 'channa' and rice for the migrants.

5. Secretary, WRD informed that the work of the raw water pipeline for the Mopa airport has been completed.
6. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 946 persons (out of them 631 are seafarers) are sheltered in quarantine facilities.
7. Secretary, Port informed that a flight is expected next week from Italy to bring stranded seafarers.
8. Shri Hemant, Nodal officer, South-Goa informed that a large number of stranded labourers are gathering at the Navelim shelter home. Fresh group of people arrives daily, as soon as the previous lot leaves to board the trains for travel to their home State.
9. MD, KTCL informed that 83 buses were operational today.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
