

## Minutes of Meeting of the State Executive Committee held at the Forest Bhavan, on 26th April, 2020

On 26/04/2020, a meeting of State Executive Committee (SEC) was held under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary (also Principal Secretary, PWD), Goa and the following other members of the SEC also attended:

1. Shri Puneet Goel, Principal Secretary, Science and Technology
2. Shri S.K. Bhandari, Secretary, Transport
3. Shri Sanjay Kumar, Secretary Revenue, Member Secretary, SEC & SDMA

The SEC was briefed about the reports on Law & Order, Trucks Movement, Relief & Shelters, and Covid Status Report (copy attached).

The other officers (as per the list Annexed), also attended the meeting as special invitees.


After deliberation on the current situation, the SEC noted and decided the following:

1. **Status of COVID19:** Secretary Health informed that no new Covid-19 case has been detected after 3rd April 2020. As on date, Goa has had seven positive cases of Covid-19, and all seven patients have recovered. After recovery, these patients are shifted to a Quarantine facility outside the Covid Hospital. 99 tests for Covid (this includes tests done on the samples collected so far of those who were surveyed during the House-to-House survey), were done during the last 24 hours, on SARI/ILI patients, all of which were negative. The SEC noted with caution that Goa had not yet faced any community transmission.
2. Secretary, Health informed that a team of Health officials has been deployed at the Hotel where the crew of Marella Discovery would be kept for Quarantine purpose. Secretary, Port informed that only 35 crew of Marella Discovery have received e-Pass from DG Shipping office, and others are expected to receive it soon. Thereafter, the crew would move by road. The DIG informed that the police will escort these seafarers to the designated Hotel as soon as they enter the State.
3. Secretary, Health informed that the GoI has allocated some more PPEs and N95 masks for the State. The Principal Resident Commissioner, Goa in Delhi is making arrangements for airlifting it from Delhi to Goa.
4. Secretary, Port informed that the crew of 'Karnika' ship may disembark at Goa though their plan is yet to be finalised. The SEC reiterated that for all such cases, the State would follow the directives of the MHA, SOP issued by the DG Shipping and State's SOP.



5. Director, IT informed that the software changes based on IGP's requirements have been done. Other changes, as per the requirement of the Health department, are being worked on.
6. The Nodal Officer (Foreigners) informed that till date 6313 foreigners have left Goa in 32 special ferry flights from Goa.
7. Commissioner (Excise) informed that the liquor manufacturers have produced about 3.66 lakh liters of hand sanitisers.
8. Secretary, Panchayat informed that Panchayats have issued 264 permissions under self-employed category, in addition to permission granted to 61 crushers.
9. PCE(PWD) informed that the pump at Padocem could not be made functional despite all efforts. The department plans to install a new pump by Wednesday. The water supply to other areas is normal.
10. CE(Electricity) informed that electricity supply is normal in the State. The department has also installed and tested the inverters at the three border checkpoints in North. The installation of inverters at checkpoints of South-Goa would be taken up soon. The SEC appreciated the speedy work of inverters' installation done by the Electricity department.
11. The Nodal Officer for Quarantine facilities informed that a total of 52 persons are sheltered in five quarantine facilities. At Acron Homes, Candolim only one person remains. He is visiting these facilities regularly.
12. Secretary, Civil Supply informed that training of the staff deputed for monitoring of Fair Price Shops is being done, and distribution of the free as well as regular ration will start as planned from 27th April. She further informed that handling and transport contractors engaged by the department have engaged 104 labourers.
13. The SEC discussed the issue of migrant labourers. The SEC decided that both the Collectors to compile a State wise list of migrant labourers who are stranded in Goa.

Committee also conveyed to all concerned that as per MHA orders, any person violating these containment measures or not complying with the above directions will be liable to be proceeded against as per the provisions of Section 51 to 60 of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, besides legal action u/s 188 of the IPC.
