Global Epidemiological update

Globally the number of new cases and deaths slightly declined but South East Asia and the Western Pacific region continue to witness an increase in both deaths and cases. India accounts for 95% of cases and 93% of deaths in the South East Asia region.

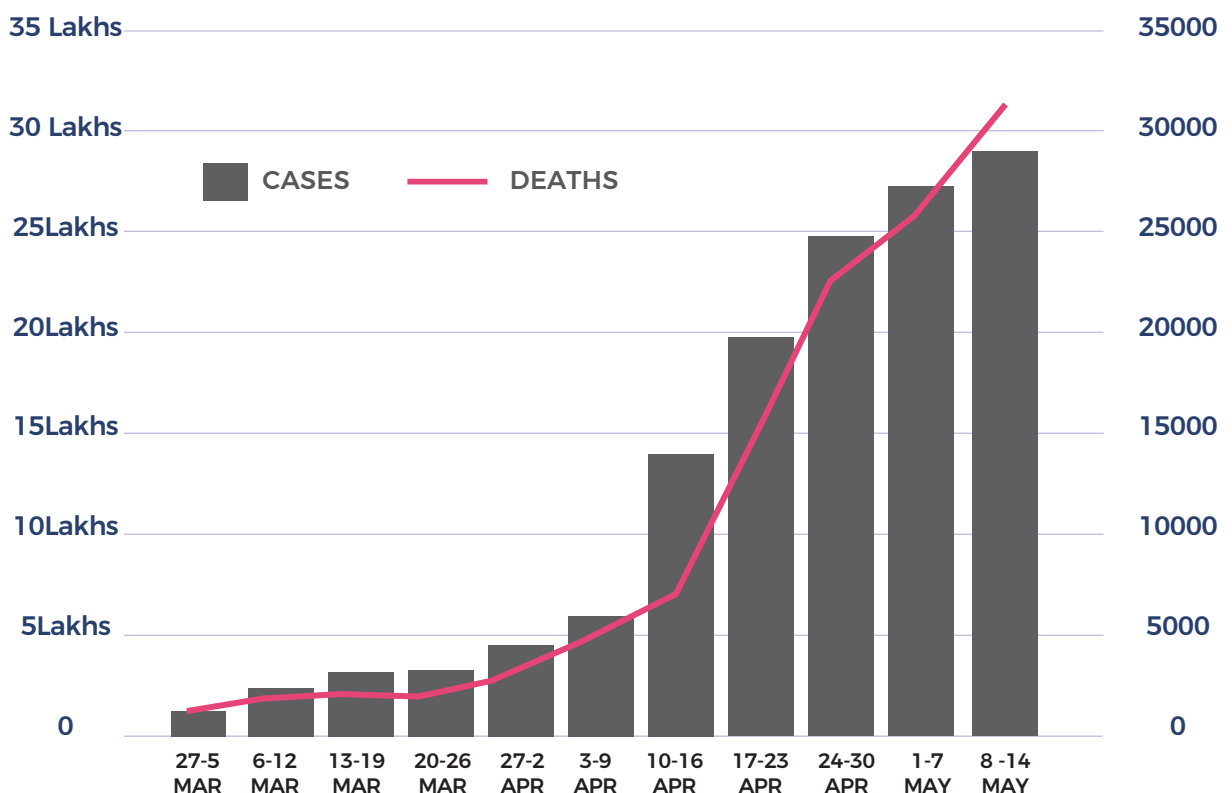
Cases and Deaths increase in the North Eastern States

The country reported 28.8 lac new cases and 32,124 deaths in the past week.

As per WHO situation report, India currently accounts for 50% of global cases and 30% of deaths.

Major affected states like Maharashtra, Delhi, UP, Gujarat, MP, Chhattisgarh and Bihar show a declining trend. North Eastern states, West Bengal, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Kerala show an increase in cases and deaths.

COVID-19 VACCINATION

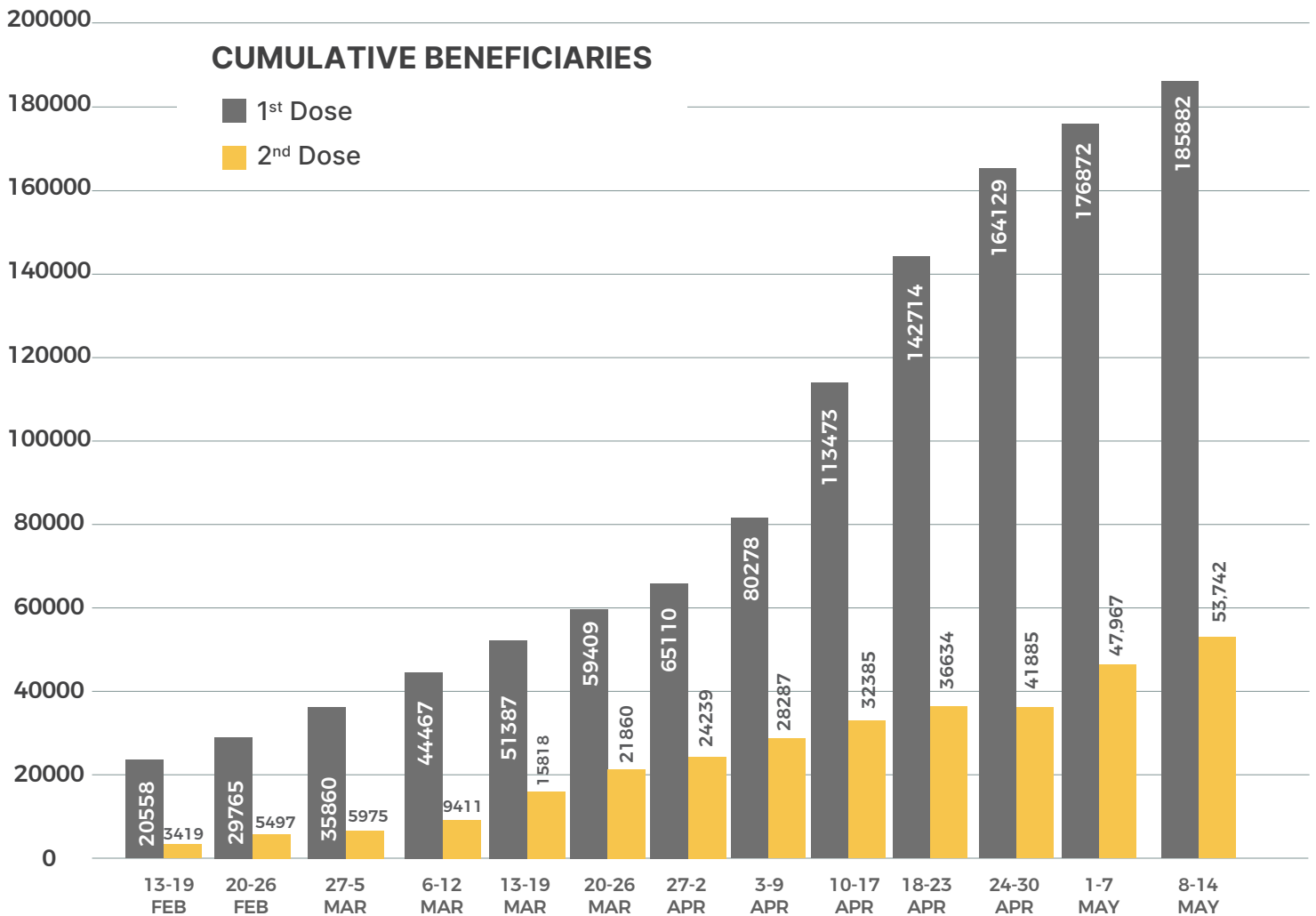
2,39,564 doses have been administered across the state till date.

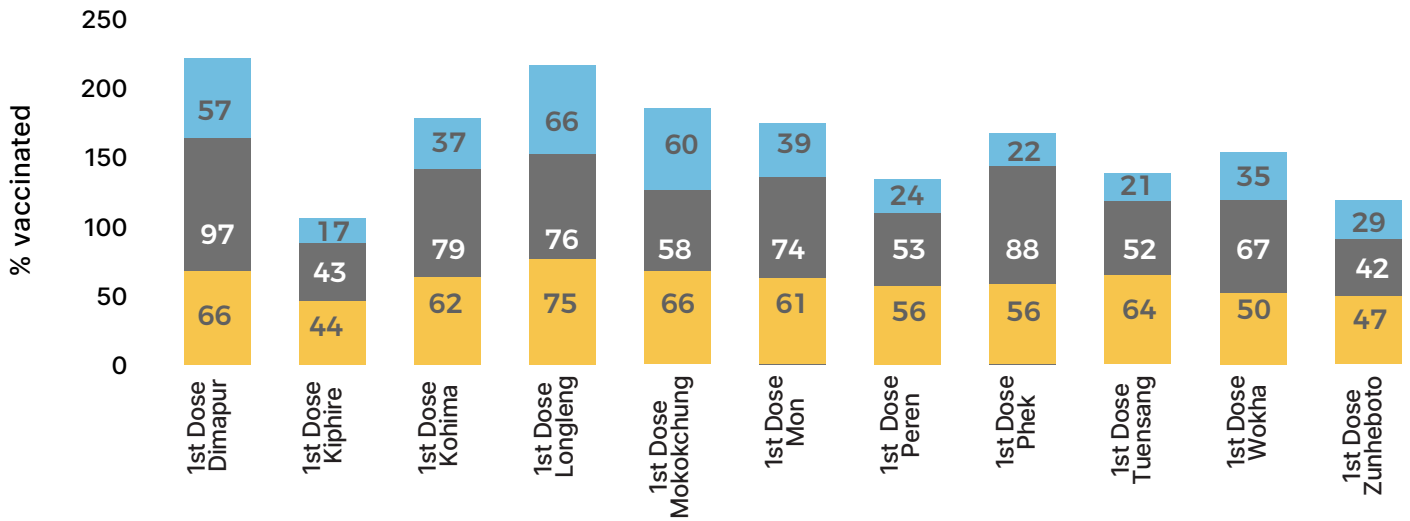

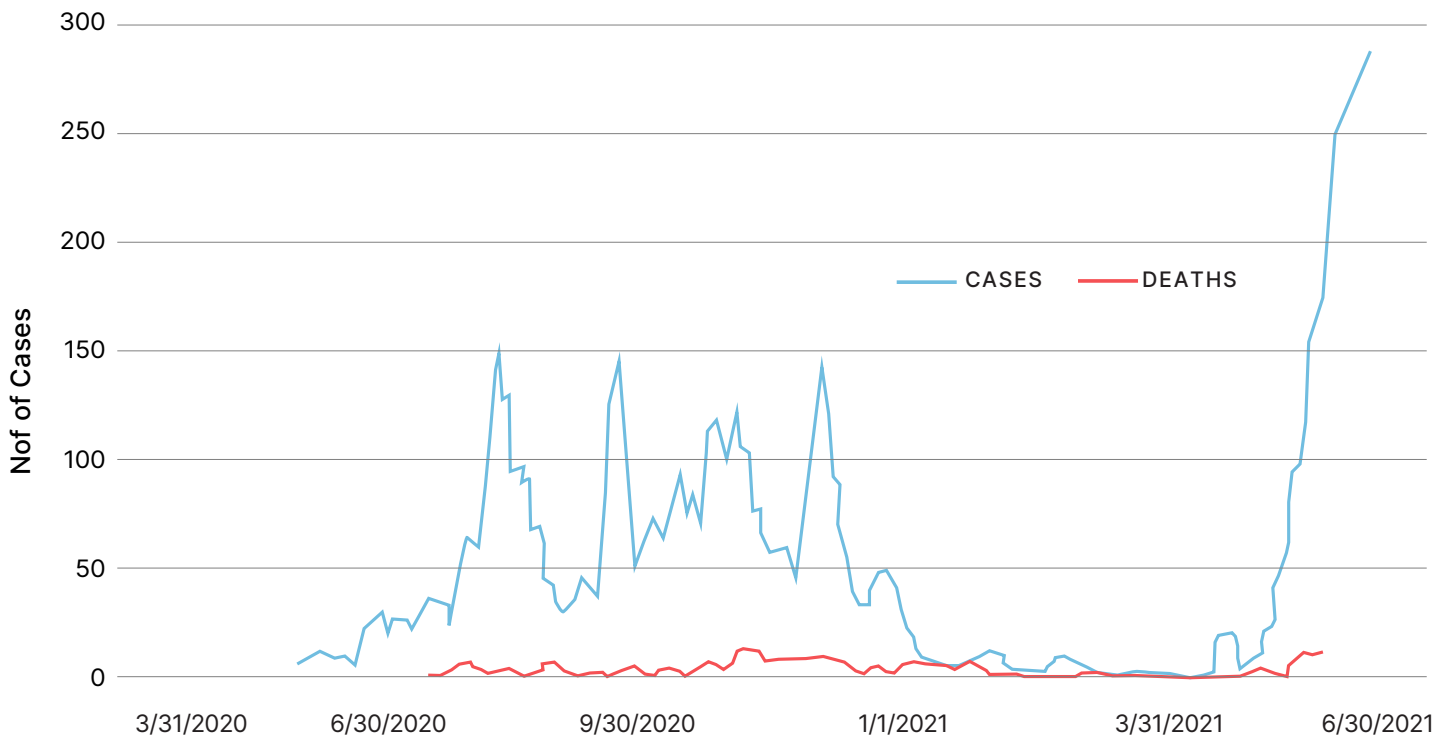
COVID19 VACCINATION STATUS 16 JAN 2021 - 15 MAY 2021

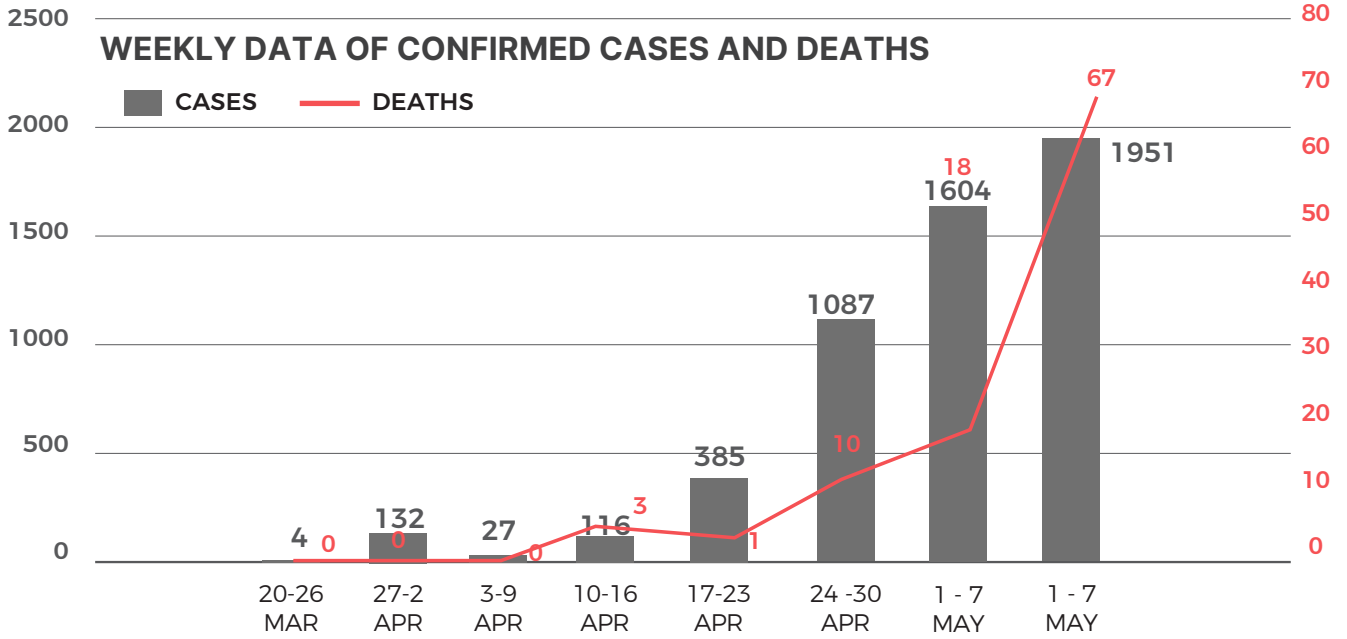
DAILY COVID-19 CASE INCREASE WITH 7 DAY MOVING AVERAGE (MAY 2020 TILL DATE)



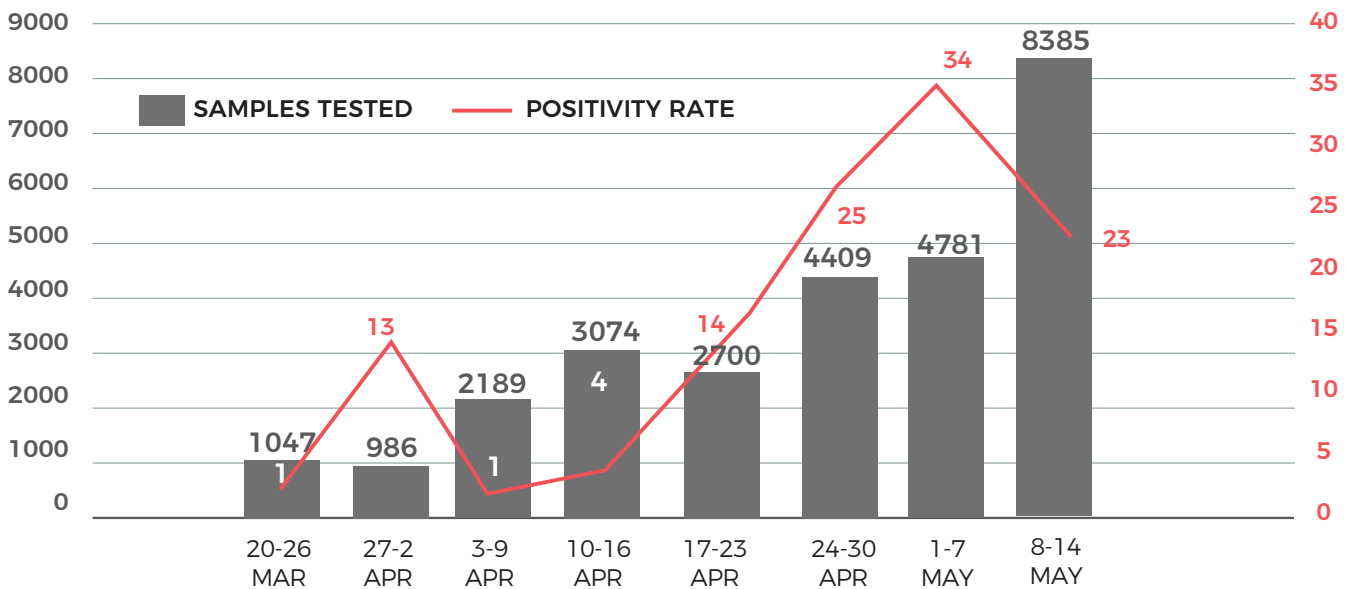
CONFIRMED CASES (weekly data)

WEEKLY DATA ON SAMPLE TESTING & SAMPLE POSITIVITY RATE

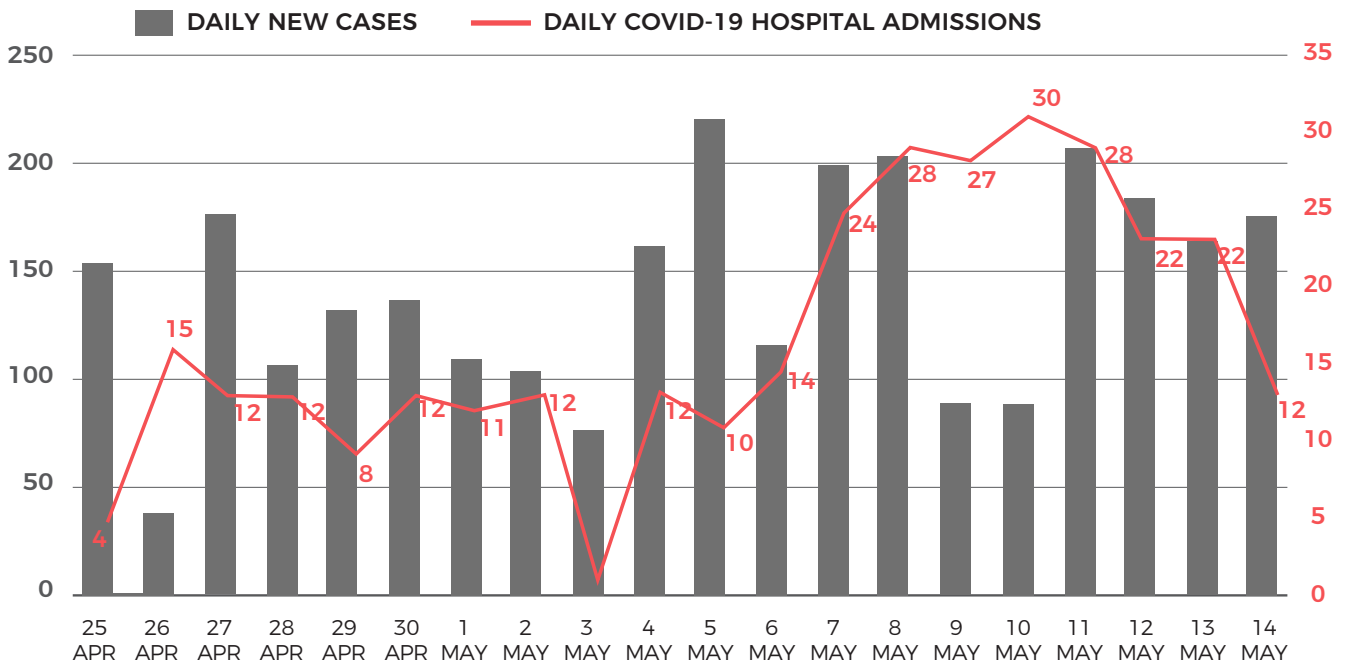

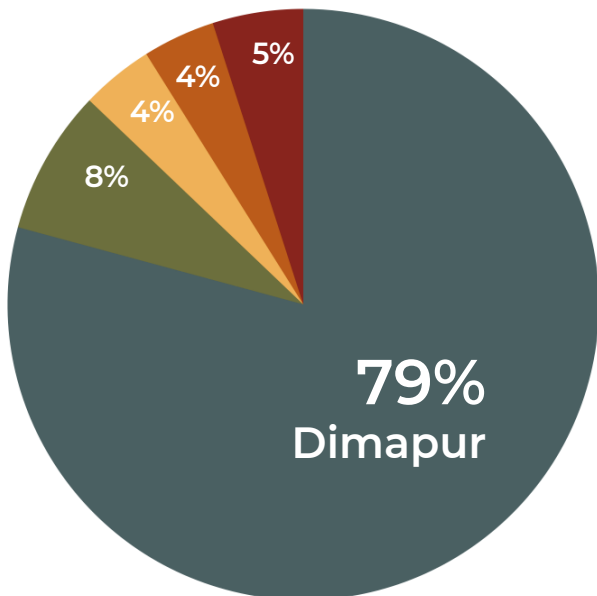

25 APRIL 2021 TILL DATE

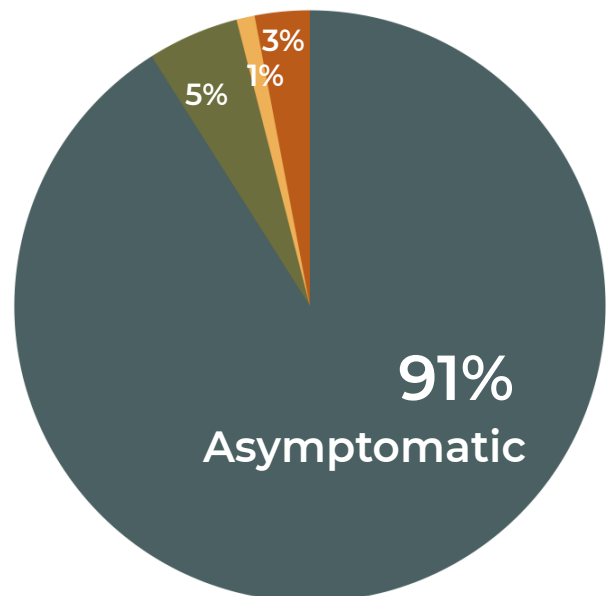

CLINICAL CLASSIFICATION OF CURRENT ACTIVE CASE

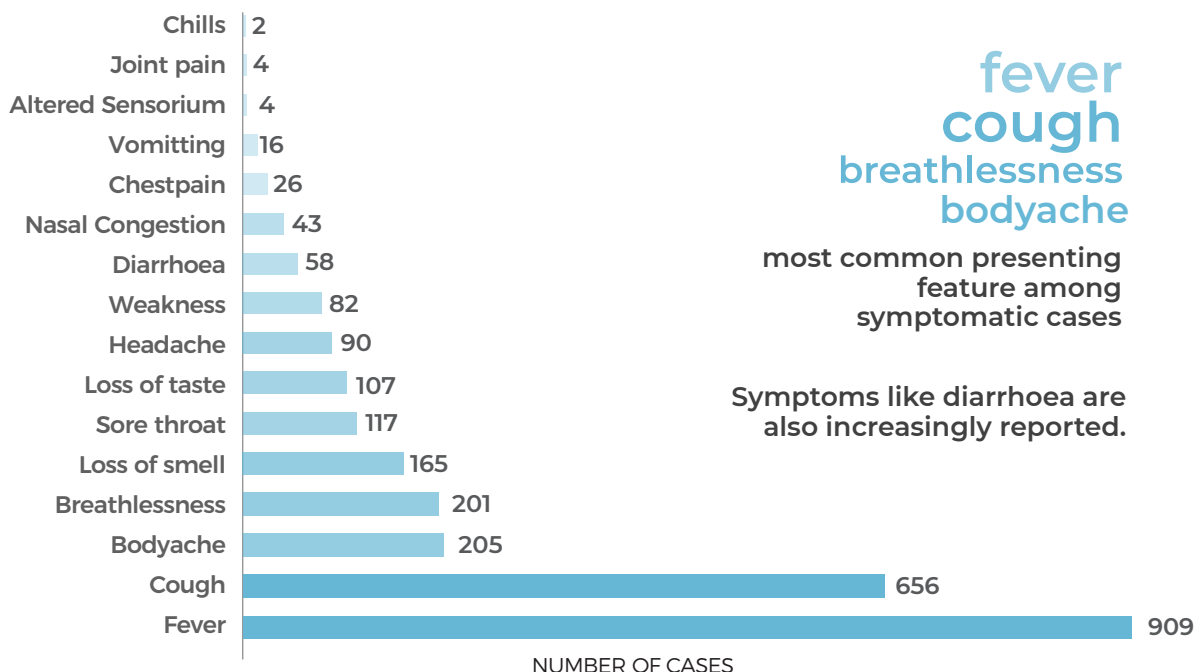

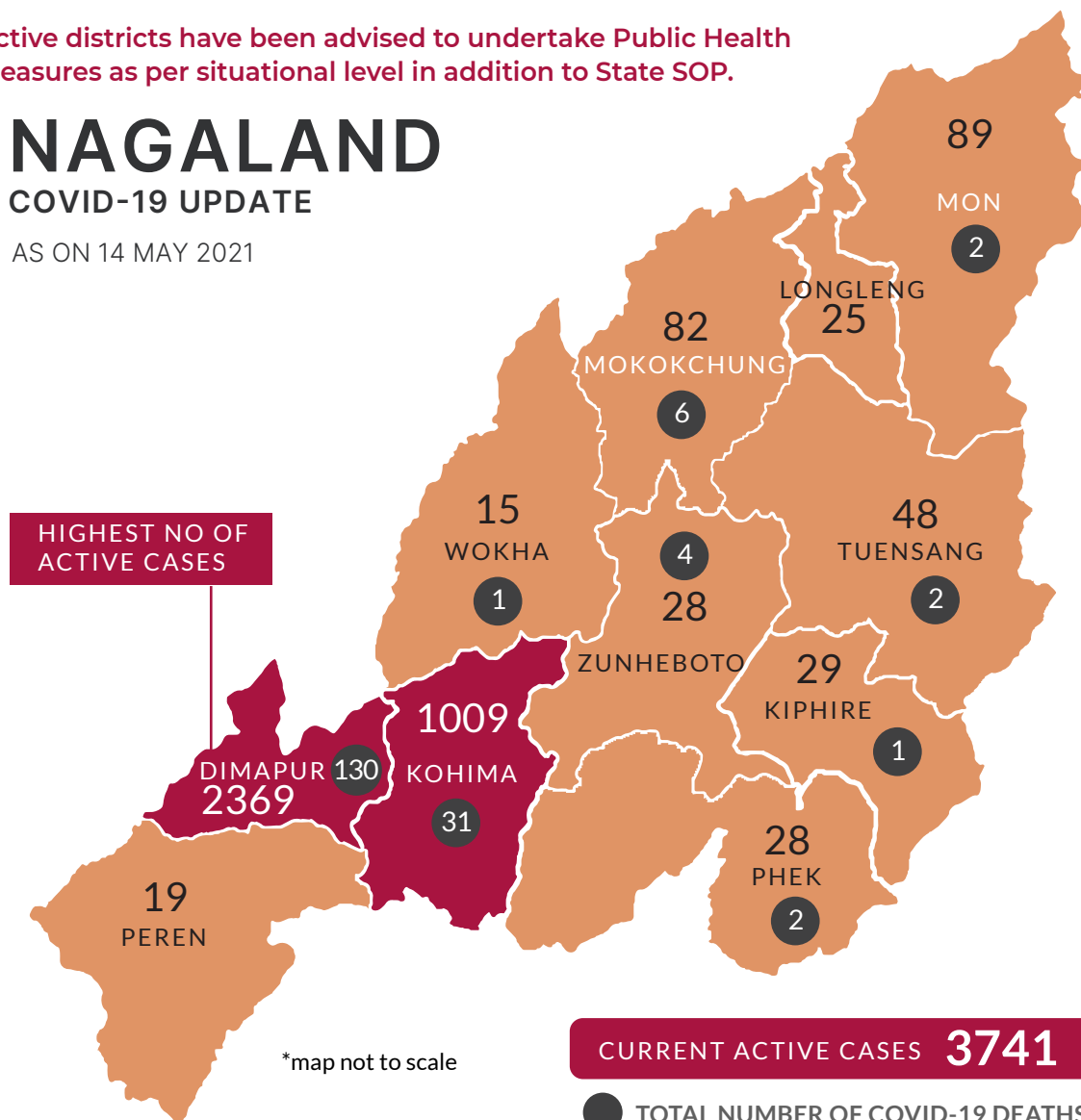
