


Global Epidemiological Update

Clobal cases continue to decrease over the globe except for the African region which has reported a 39% increase. A total of 3.89 million people has died of COVID-19 across the world.

National Update

Cases continue to decline for the 6th consecutive week in the country. 3.59 lakh cases and 9,356 deaths were reported from the last week.

ONE SUPERSPREADER EVENT REPORTED FROM MON

A total of 37 cases with a positivity rate of 40% have been reported from a Prison in Mon.

The high infectivity of SARS COV 2 in "closed spaces with poor ventilation and crowding" is again highlighted by this event.

All super spreader events have been reported from closed crowded spaces. Maximum precautions (double masking, crowd control and improving natural ventilation) is needed in closed spaces.

WEEKLY SUMMARY

- Tuensang, Phek, Wokha, Zunheboto, Peren and Mon have reported an increase in cases from the past week with the highest increase in Peren district.
- Three districts (Kohima, Mokokchung and Peren) have a weekly sample positivity rate of more than 10%. The state average is 9%
- The state reported 14 Covid-19 deaths in the week - lowest weekly deaths in 8 weeks.
- The 7-day moving average of new cases has reduced to 84 from 305 cases at the peak of the wave.
- Maximum number of positive cases in 2021 has been found in the 21–30-year age group at 28%
- Highest number of deaths in 2021 have been reported from the 45–59-year age group at 32 %
- A total of 27 deaths have been reported from home isolation as of date.






DAILY COVID-19 CASE INCREASE WITH 7 DAY MOVING AVERAGE (MAY 2020 TILL DATE)








NUMBER OF COMORBIDITIES ASSOCIATED WITH COVID-19 DEATHS


