
Global Epidemiological Update

Over 214 million cases and 4.47 million Covid-19 deaths have been confirmed globally. Increase in cases and deaths were reported from the Western Pacific and the Americas. Highest number of new cases were reported from the **USA** with hospitals getting overwhelmed by the 3rd wave especially in the states with low vaccination coverage.

National update

The weekly positivity rate is at 2.10 % with the country reporting 2.09 lakh cases and 2,897 deaths in the week.

More than 61.22 crore doses of the COVID-19 Vaccine have been administered across the country.

Surge in Pediatric cases across USA during the third wave: American Academy of Pediatrics

As infections increase across all age groups, children made up to 22% of new cases in the past week in USA and 1% of confirmed cases were hospitalized as per a report from the AAP.

CENTERS FOR DISEASE CONTROL AND PREVENTION (CDC)

Vaccination status of Covid-19 Deaths and Positive cases in the second wave (March '21 till date)

- 99% of COVID-19 deaths are not fully vaccinated and 90% of deaths have not received even a single dose in the second wave
- 78% of positive cases in the second wave are among the unvaccinated and 14 % of positive cases had received a single dose

The main aim of vaccination is to break the chain between positivity and hospitalization or death. Vaccinated people still must wear a mask, follow hand hygiene and avoid crowded places.

WEEKLY SUMMARY


- The weekly sample positivity rate now stands at 2.3%. Mokokchung (6%) has reported a weekly positivity of more than 5%. The weekly sample positivity rate was 34% in the 1st week of May '21.
- 359 new cases and 5 deaths (Dimapur 4, Peren 1) were reported from the week. 55 new admissions were also reported from Covid-19 hospitals.
- 8.49 lakh doses of Covid-19 vaccine have been administered across the state. Dimapur, Kohima, Mokokchung, Mon and Longleng have the highest first dose coverage among eligible beneficiaries.
- 15,864 samples were tested in the week and 359 cases were detected. This is the highest number of samples tested in a single week till date. Highest samples were collected from Dimapur and Zunheboto.
- 600 Covid-19 deaths have been confirmed in the State. Dimapur (365 deaths) reported 60% of all deaths followed by Kohima (18%) and Mokokchung (8%).
- 99% of Covid-19 deaths in the second wave
 (March '21 till date) are not fully vaccinated and
 90% have not received even a single dose.






TOTAL WEEKLY VACINE DOSES ADMINISTERED



WEEKLY DOSES ADMINISTERED IN THE LAST 6 WEEKS




DAILY COVID-19 CASE INCREASE WITH 7 DAY MOVING AVERAGE



WEEKLY DATA OF CONFIRMED CASES AND DEATHS












WEEKLY NEW COVID-19 HOSPITAL ADMISSIONS AGAINST TOTAL CONFIRMED CASES



All people with such underlying diseases should be vaccinated at the earliest.


