### MIGRANTS:

Large number of migrant population is entering the state from across the country. The Honorable Chief Minister has instructed the state officials to ensure that the asymptomatic migrants arriving in Telangana through various points of entry are quarantined at home and in government quarantine facilities. The symptomatic migrants will be isolated for diagnostic test and for further course of action.

**Till date 25 migrants have been tested positive for Covid-19.**

The general public are requested to inform the local authorities in case they identify any new persons, migrants who have newly arrived in the towns and villages.

To screen the migrants entering into the state, 275 health teams have been deployed at 87 check posts in the border districts. About 1000 health personnel are working in these teams.

## DEATHS

**Two deaths have occurred today. The details are as given below**

- 1) A 61yr old male from Moosa Bowli in Hyderabad with associated co-morbidities like Hypertension.
- 2) A 65yr old male from Jiyaguda, Hyderabad was referred from KIMS Hyderabad, and admitted today at Gandhi hospital. He is suffering from Diabetes and Hypertension

## APPEAL TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN VIEW OF RELAXATION

- **Physical Distancing:** Always maintain a safe distance of at least 6 feet from others. Close contact with strangers is to be avoided. Maintain safe distance at markets, workplace and during travel.
- **Face Masks:** The Citizens are requested to wear face masks as it is the first line of defense against infection. Homemade double layered face masks are effective in preventing infection. The masks should not be frequently adjusted by touching on the external surface. They should be washed every day and can be reused.
- **Influenza like illness (ILI):** In case of any Flu/ Influenza like symptoms such as cough, sore throat, running nose, fever, difficulty in breathing, body pains and headache, please report to the nearest government health facility without delay.
- **Self reporting:** The Citizens are requested to reach out and report to the nearest government health facility in case they have come in contact with a Covid-19
