Situation Update, Uttarakhand: Today

WHO has declared the Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) epidemic as Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) under IHR (International Health Regulation). In this context, Uttarakhand Government has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. Isolation and Institutional Quarantine facilities are operational in all districts. To combat the pandemic, the Government has operationalized 38 dedicated COVID Hospitals and 420 COVID Care Centres (CCC).

Public Health Action Taken

- To enhance the COVID-19 testing capacity, the State Government has decided to conduct 24x7 testing facility in Govt. Medical College Haldwani, Dehradun & Srinagar Garhwal.
- To combat the pandemic situation, the State Government has commenced Home Isolation strategy for self isolation of asymptomatic COVID-19 positive patient.
- To facilitate the early management of COVID-19 positive patients, the State Government has designated 20 Private Hospitals as COVID dedicated facility.
- The Government has decided the user charges/cost of treatment for private hospitals to treat COVID-19 patients.

Details of Patients Treated & Cured and Death summary:

- **Treated & Cured:** Five Hundred Thirty-two (532) patients discharged in different districts (Almora– 16, Bageshwar– 10, Chamoli– 46, Champawat– 00, Dehradun– 136, Haridwar– 45, Nainital– 04, Pauri– 197, Pithoragarh– 19, Rudraprayag– 01, Tehri– 06, U.S. Nagar– 08 & Uttarkashi– 44).
- **Death:** Seven (07) COVID-19 positive patients expired in the state in last 24 hours. As per information provided by the respective hospitals, the death summary is as below:
 - (1) A 82-year-old female expired in Max Hospital, Dehradun due to Refractory Shock, MultiOrgan Dysfunction, Metabolic Acidosis & Type 1 Respiratory Failure.
 - (2) A 64-year-old male expired in AIIMS Rishikesh, Dehradun due to Ventricular Trachycardia, COVID Pneumonia & Septic Shock.
 - (3) A 22-year-old female expired in Himalayan Hospital, dehradun due to Sudden Cardiac Arrest.
 - (4) A 60-year-old male expired in Himalayan Hospital, Dehradun due to Acute Respiratory Distress Syndrome & Metabolic Acidosis.
 - (5) A 85 year old male expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Sudden CardioPulmonary Arrest, Severe Acute Respiratory Illness, Bilateral Pneumonitis, Type 2 Respiratory Failure, Acue Kidney Injury & Shock.
 - (6) A 60-year-old female expired in Dr. Susheela Tiwari Govt. Hospital, Haldwani due to Acute CardioPulmonary Arrest, Bilateral Pneumonitis & Severe Acute Respiratory Illness.
 - (7) A 48-year-old female expired in Shri Mahant Indiresh Hospital, Dehradun due to CardioPulmonary Arrest, Bilateral pnenmonia & Acute Kidney Injury.










