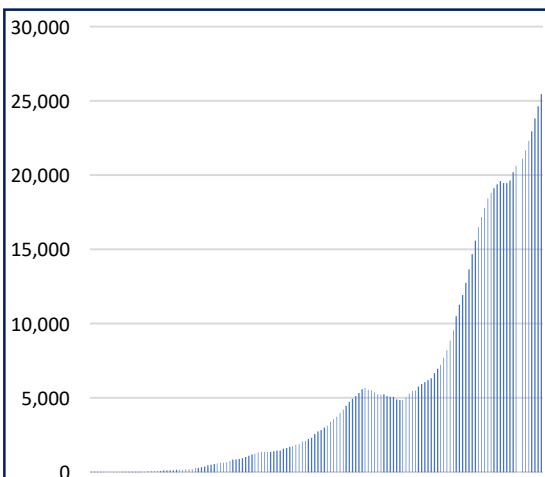

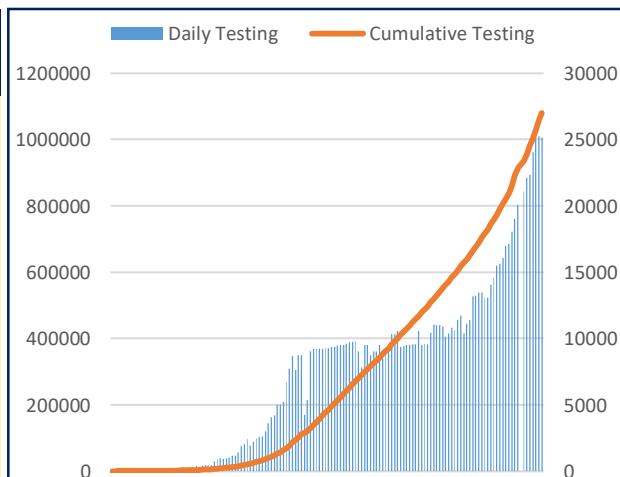
DAILY CUMULATIVE ACTIVE

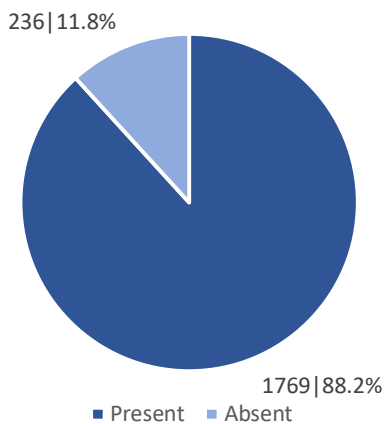

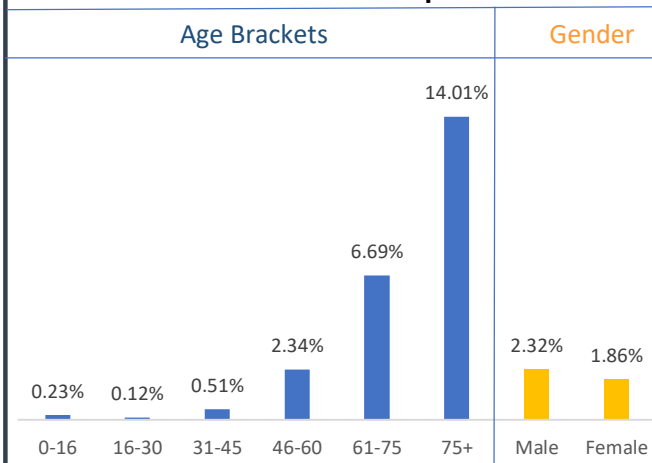

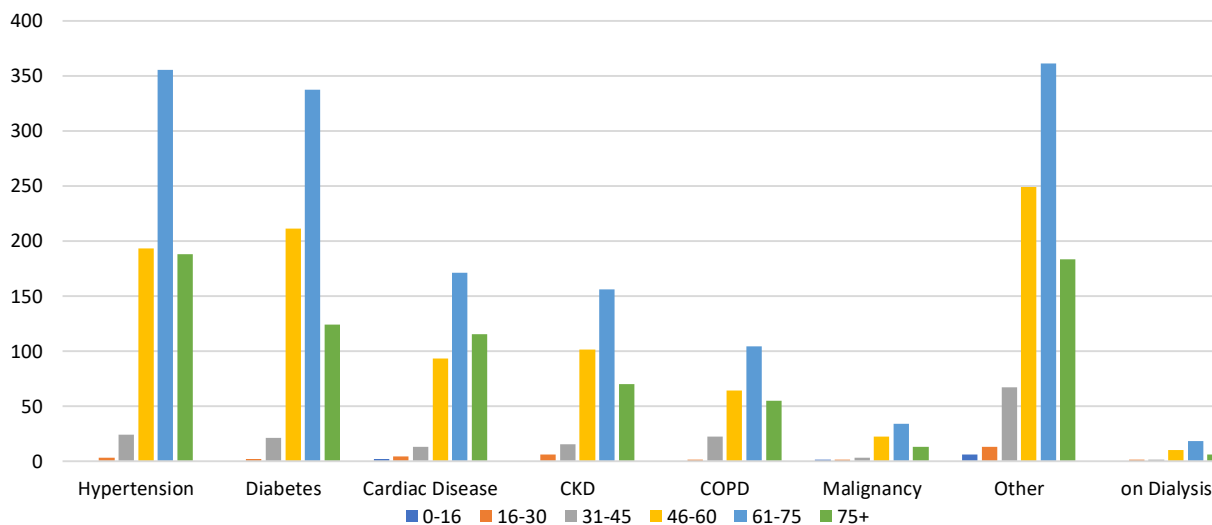
### Comorbidity Status in Deceased Cases (n=2,005)



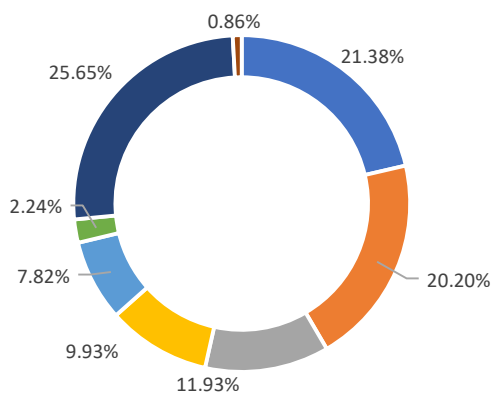
### Fatality Rate in Respective Age Brackets & Gender Group



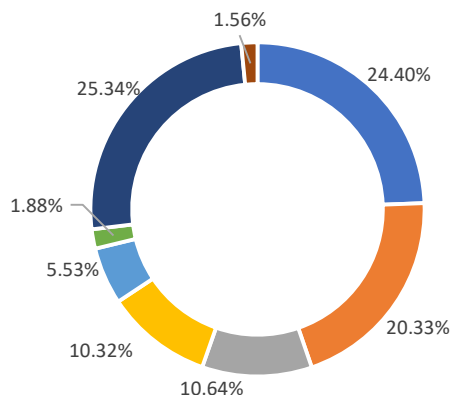
### Age Group Wise Comorbidities Among Deceased

- Safe Homes : An initiative by the Government of West Bengal for care and treatment of asymptomatic/mild symptomatic COVID patients for whom home isolation is not possible /advisable
- As per State Government advisory Satellite Health Facilities are being developed by private hospitals in close vicinity of their hospitals as separate health facility for treatment of asymptomatic/mild symptomatic COVID patients. This intervention is expected to free beds in the hospitals for serious patients.
