



DAILY CUMULATIVE ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES











NTERVENTIONS STATE GOVT

- Treatment is free for all patients in all Government Hospitals
- Govt has requisitioned private hospitals as COVID hospitals
- Govt reimburses these hospitals at already notified rates
- Govt has instituted a Cabinet Committee for better management of the COVID-19 crisis, chaired by Dr. Amit Mitra, and co-chaired by Shri Partha Chatterjee
- Govt has notified Medical College and Hospital, Kolkata as a full-fledged tertiary level COVID Hospital
- Govt has also notified KPC Medical College & Hospital, Kolkata as the 69th dedicated COVID Hospital in the state for specialized COVID treatment
