12 new deaths and 236 new cases confirmed

- the Health Protection Surveillance Centre (HPSC) has been notified that 12 people diagnosed with COVID-19 in Ireland have died - bringing the total deaths to 1,458
- 236 additional cases of COVID-19 have been confirmed in Ireland
- there are now 22,996 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Ireland
